KENT'S KORNER:

A few years ago I read the book written by John MacArthur entitled *Twelve Ordinary Men*. This book presents a mini-biography based on Scripture about each one of the twelve disciples. When we think of the disciples, we almost always think of the most famous 3: Peter, James, & John. Or perhaps we think of Matthew, author of one of the Gospels. We might even think of the most infamous disciple named Judas. Somewhere down the list of names we would think of Andrew. After reading MacArthur's book, Andrew became one of my favorite characters in the Bible. According to John 1:40-42, John & Andrew were the two who first followed after Jesus. But as I read these verses, I began to see how Andrew played a key role in the beginning of Jesus' ministry. "One of the two who heard John (the Baptist) speak, and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother Simon, and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which is translated, the Christ). And he brought him to Jesus." In fact, MacArthur points out that Andrew seemed to have a zeal for introducing others to Jesus, and this is typical of Andrew's character! In addition, Andrew was the disciple who brought the young boy to Jesus with the 5 loaves and 2 fish in John 6:9! And finally, Andrew, along with Philip, was instrumental in introducing some Greeks to Jesus in John 12:20-22! Andrew saw the value of individual people!

As we are now in the midst of the "Who's Your One?" emphasis, we would do well to follow the example of Andrew as he brought others to Jesus! If God can use an ordinary fisherman such as Andrew, He can certainly use us! who's your
