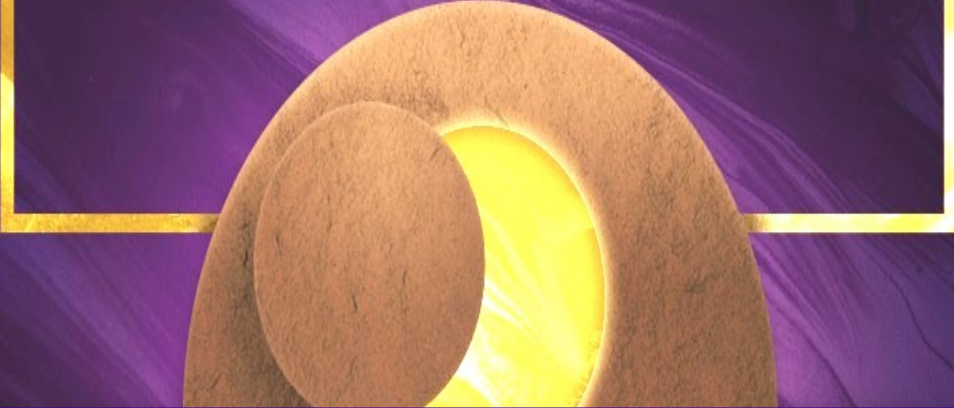

Kent's Korner: Praying for Revival & Spiritual Awakening, Part 2

As we continue to look forward to our “Here’s Hope” event (see below for details), here are 2 more points of prayer emphasis to focus on this month...

2. Pray for God to bestow spiritual hunger in His people and draw them to fervent intercession. God has to grant people the genuine faith and the fervent desire for prayer. With all our promotion and programming, we cannot “produce” a genuine prayer movement or revival. In *Philippians 2:13*, Paul wrote these words, “For it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.”

3. Pray also that God will bring unity in our churches and a deep harmony between our churches. In *John 13:35* we read these words, “By this shall all people know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.”
