KENT'S KORNER: "Two Types of Listeners" — Acts 17:10-12, James 1:22-24,

Matthew 13:9

Are you still hungry to hear from the Lord?

It's possible to "listen" to every word of a sermon while actually not hearing a word of it. Sadly, this happens in churches every week-. In our world there are two types of listeners: passive and active.

Passive listener: one who attends, even regularly, but just sit in the pew and let their mind wander. They simply go
because it's their Sunday habit. They are present physically, but not mentally or spiritually! They may be thinking about
their "to do" list for the next week, where to go for lunch, or just checking out others who may be in the worship service.
They may even attend to avoid feeling guilty; going makes them feel better about themselves.

Active listener: walk into the sanctuary excited to worship the Lord and expecting to hear an important message from Him. They have their Bible with them, along with a journal and pen, ready to write down the important points of the message. As they listen, they are eager to ask themselves, How does this apply to my life?

If we want to truly hear what god wants to say to us, we must be determined to be active listeners. Of course, there are times when it's especially difficult to stay focused, but we must be intentional about eliminating distractions and focusing on hearing and applying God's Word. Pray and ask the Lord to help you grow in this area!
