No Associational Meeting in March

Kent's Korner: Hearing God's Voice!

"Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.....He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.....Who, then, are those who fear the Lord? He will instruct them in the ways they should choose." – Psalm 25: 4-12

How can we know that we are following the Lord and making right decisions? God desires to guide us and teach us, but first we must come before Him with a humble spirit and a willingness to obey His will. Here are some steps we must take before we can hear from Him and know His will:

- 1) CLEAR THE PATHWAY – we must repent of all known sin! (Psalm 25:7,11) We cannot hear from God and make good decisions if there is unconfessed sin in our lives! And remember that sin is also not doing what we know God wants us to do (sins of omission)!
- 2) EXERCISE PATIENCE – wait on the Lord! Know that your only hope is in Him! (Psalm 25:5) Be careful not to rush ahead of Him! "Wait patiently for the Lord, be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the Lord." – Psalm 27:14
- 3) PERSIST IN PRAYER – don't give up! Pray through until the answer comes! "The need for persistence is designed to effect such a change in us that we conform to the character and will of the God who eagerly waits to hear our cry" (Tom Elliff in A Passion for Prayer). "Keep on asking, and you will receive...Keep on seeking, and you will find...Keep on knocking...." – Matthew 7:7 NLT.
- 4) SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES – God's Word provides wisdom for all of life's challenges! "Guide me in your truth and teach me..." (Ps. 25:5). "Your statutes are my delight; they are my counselors." (Ps. 119:24) "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." (Ps. 119:105) As we spend time consistently in God's word, the Holy Spirit will guide us and point us in the right direction.
